Aiyenero Continuing Education (ACE) Scholarship

History

This scholarship was created in memory of Pastor Amos Omotoye Aiyenero the father of Rev. Abiola Florence Adegboruwa. Pastor A. O. Aiyenero was a minister of God at C.M.S. Anglican Church Ikorodu Road and C.M.S. Church Jemuje Ajegunle Apapa Lagos. He was a faithful servant of God, a dedicated husband and a loving father. He died on November 8, 1990 at the young age of 102.

As a man of integrity who loved people, he always believed that striving for higher education was important. This scholarship provides financial assistance and encouragement to students who demonstrate a pursuit for continuing education and are making a difference in the Christian community.

Value

Up to two scholarships worth \$1000 each (Canadian fund) will be awarded.

Eligibility

All applicants of the **Aiyenero Continuing Education (ACE) Scholarship** must be Canadian Citizens or must permanently reside in Canada. Applicants must be **17-25** years of age as of September 1st of the year in which the scholarship is applied for.

Applicants must be enrolled in a full-time or part-time degree (undergraduate or graduate), diploma or certificate program at an accredited Canadian college or university (approved by the Prayer House Ministry Scholarship Committee) for the academic year commencing or continuing in the year in which the scholarship application is submitted.

Applicants applying for the ACE scholarship cannot have been previous winners of the scholarship.

Family members of or those immediately affiliated with Prayer House Ministry are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Applicants who have not previously won the award in the current year can reapply again in the next year.

Criteria

1. Minimum academic average of 70% or greater
2. Recognized contribution in the Christian community (e.g. church, school, organization, etc). Brief description of your contribution in the community.
3. All applicants of the ACE scholarship must complete and submit the following documents.
 - a. An up-to-date official school transcript in the scholarship year.
 - b. Letter of reference from two individuals named in your application. This person must have known you for at least six months. A letter of reference cannot be from a family member. Letters of reference can be from:
 - i. A teacher, principal, or academic advisor from your high school, college or university;
 - ii. Someone familiar with your service in the Christian community;
 - iii. An individual from an organization, sports, or volunteer committee
 - c. Complete an essay answering questions on a topic related to PHMI yearly theme of the year.
 - d. Proof of acceptance to any full-time or part-time to an accredited College or University program in Canada,
 - e. Your secondary transcript.
 - f. Your contact information including your full name, mailing Address, email and phone number.
 - g. Your picture

Applicants who apply for the ACE scholarship must meet the criteria for the award and complete the application requirements to be considered for the scholarship. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that their application is complete and that all required information, documents and letters are enclosed with the application. Failure to provide ALL the required documents and/or information by the designated deadline will result in disqualification. Falsification of information will result in disqualification.

Deadline

Applications must be received by Prayer House Ministry Int. each year on **July 31st @ 11:59:59** online.

Results

Scholarship recipients will be notified by September 15th of the year applied. Only recipients will be notified. The recipients will be and awarded by October 15th of the year applied. The Scholarship Committee wishes to thank all applicants for their interest in the ACE scholarship.
